



Pick-up service

Pick-up will be provided at selected central Bangkok hotels or meeting point from 06:30 AM. The tour operator will tell you the nearest meeting point and time.

Highlights



- Explore Khao Yai National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage site
- Take a hike to Heaw Narok Waterfall, a top attraction of the park
- Enjoy a 3-hour Thai cooking class including a Thai market tour
- Meet and greet a female Asian elephant and feed her fruits or vegetables

Following a hotel pick-up at 06:30 AM, head to a local morning market and learn how to choose fresh ingredients for your cooking class.



Aprons, chopping boards and chef's knives will all be provided as you learn to cook 5 popular Thai dishes. At the end of the lesson, enjoy a delicious meal with fresh fruits or a Thai dessert.

Afterwards, enter Khao Yai National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage site, and take a short hike to Heaw Narok Waterfall.

Learn about Thai elephants during a short briefing by your guide. Touch and photograph the elephants, and feed them bananas and sugar cane.

At the end of the day, transfer back to Bangkok or stay at our farm, (with a hotel drop off at approximately 07:00 PM.)
